## **Object without features**

With the series TMS I researched the vulnerability and convertibility of plains and structures and reached the borders of the material's possibilities by selectively cutting it. I analyzed how the material reacts, and what was possible without any strong effort. By this the plain mutated into a volume. It is a metamorphose, but not generating a completely different object. Rather a metamorphose on half way. Depending on the perspective and light, the result flickers between emptiness, surface, and volume.

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SCHWEINI is produced with the same technic as the light series TMS is. It consists of a rectangular copper sheet and can easily be folded by hand. In contrast to TMS SCHWEINI is a completed metamorphose. The sheet transforms into a completely different object. An object that, like the sheet, has no function. By this, Schweini celebrates only the folding process metamorphose itself.

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
